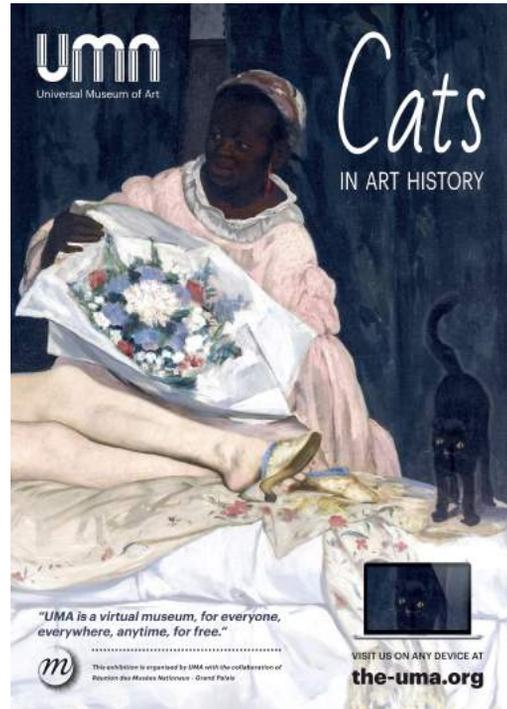
'Cats in Art History' proposes an attractive subject, judging from the felines' success on the internet and in everyday life. The exhibition will delight audiences of all ages: its topic speaks to everyone, yet the exhibition is also full of surprises – a new way of looking at the greatest artworks, a new approach to detail – and it encompasses the history of the cat's representation across the centuries.

For the 'Cats in Art History' exhibition, UMA has had access to the images of the greatest national collections (among which the Louvre's, Orsay's, or Versailles') thanks to the bank of images of the Réunion des Musées-Grand Palais' Photo Agency.

With this fourth exhibition in virtual reality, UMA keeps one of our initial promises: by working with the museums, UMA offers them a new kind of visibility thanks to the ever-increasing website traffic, and allows them to showcase a collection and make it digitally accessible to the greatest numbers.
